Nelson's Chicken is on Sunday, October 24 at Juergens Do It Best Center in Huntington. 192 chickens have already been sold to date. 400 chickens is the break-even point. All members to get their money turned in by Friday to Mat at Bippus Bank.

Gail Gibson volunteered to bring preordered chickens back to the State Farm office in Roanoke for local Roanoke residents to pick up there.
4. Flower baskets for 2010 season
A quote was submitted from Stuckeys' Greenhouse. There are more quotes to be submitted so decisions were tabled. There are 36 hanging baskets in downtown Roanoke so the greenhouses are being asked to quote for a total of 40-50 baskets to incorporate more baskets throughout town. Discussion included the possibility of having residents purchase them as well. The discussion also included the additional expense of watering.
5. Benches for the 2010 season
Scott Carroll has received information about the heavy duty, all metal, high quality benches used outdoors year round in parks and city streets. There are some really nice \$1,000 benches that are available wholesale at \$400 - \$500.

Scott will bring the bench catalogue to the next meeting. A decision was made to approach some people to see if they would like to donate a bench and have their name put on it. The benches were tabled until the next meeting.
